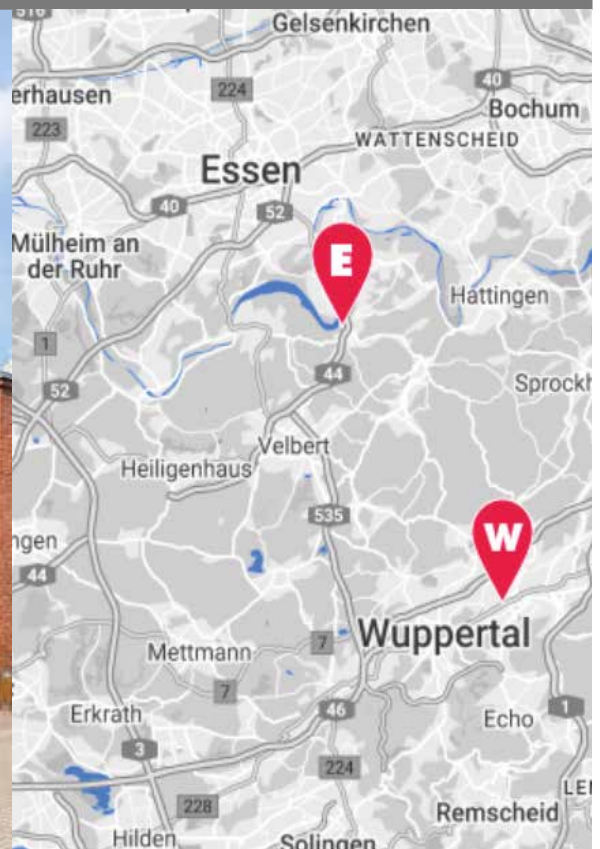

(e.g., required disability support)
